Classic Sailing in French Pass

The Crosilles-French Pass Road, one of New Zealand's most spectacular scenic drives, terminates in the idyllic settlement of French Pass, jumping off place for travellers to D'Urville Island, and the point of departure for our traditional sailing cruises. Steadfast is a lovingly maintained French pilot cutter with spacious open decks, traditional rig, and classic detail. Guests are invited to participate in setting sail, and the pleasure of heeling over in this beautiful 40 tonne gaff cutter is an experience not to be missed. Listen to the tuis and bell birds singing from the coastal forest or the sound of a gannet plunging into the sea!



Hard Tack Morning Cruise: Our morning cruise departs daily from French Pass, and takes in the sights of Admiralty Bay and the D'Urville Island coast. Morning tea with the gannets and shearwaters. Experience the pleasure of sailing a big gaff rigger! Departing the wharf in French Pass daily at 930 am, and returning around 1230pm. Bookings essential.
